

Dream Foundation Scholarship Application

The attached application will cover the Dream 4 It scholarship awards for 2020. Completed application packages are due by **June 21, 2020**. Scholarship awards are announced by July 22, 2020. The Foundation offers three separate scholarships including the general Dream 4 It Foundation Scholarship and, legacy scholarships in memory of Reginald Combs and Mark Edward Griffin. You can learn more about our “Legacy Designees” on our website.

All scholarship funds have the same basic requirements, with the Mark Edward Griffin Memorial Scholarship including additional stipulations. Scholars should complete one application – detailing, where indicated on the application cover sheet, if they meet the stipulations for the Mark Edward Griffin Memorial Scholarship.

The following general requirements must be met:

- Applicant must be a high school senior who will be a freshmen in fall 2019 pursuing a 4 or 2-year degree (acceptance letter must be provided).
- Applicants must submit a copy of their fourth quarter report card showing their cumulative GPA for the year with the application. With a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Given the situation with Covid-19, the application review committee has adjusted this requirement. Applicants should provide their grades through the *second* quarter. The 3.0 cumulative GPA requirement will be based on the first two quarters for the 2019-2020 school year. Direct questions to dream4itinc@gmail.com.
- Applicants must complete a minimum of 1 (single space) or 2 page essay (double spaced) - which shares with the review committee the applicant’s “Dream” for their future. The essay should also include information about the applicant’s community involvement ((location, tenure, duties, volunteer hours (weekly, monthly), etc.
- Applicants must provide three recommendation letters which are addressed to the Dream 4 It Foundation’s scholarship. Letters not addressed to the Dream 4 It Foundation, will not be accepted. The letters should reflect active participation in Church, Civic or School Organizations and one letter should be from a school representative (teacher, principal, career counselor). The letters should provide the author’s contact information and should only be one page in length.

For the Mark Edward Griffin Scholarship Fund, applicants must:

- Be a resident of the State of Georgia accepted to an accredited college or university (institution can be outside the State of Georgia), **OR**
- Accepted at Towson State University (State of Georgia residency not required)

Applications will be rated based on the following information:

- ✓ A minimum 3.0 average on a 4.0 scale.
- ✓ The submission and content of the applicant essay.
- ✓ The submission and content of recommendation letters.
